

On the Policy Ideals and Principle of the Pluralist Participation in the Governance of Science¹

Abstract: The Pluralist Participation in the Governance of Science is a standardized pluralist approach to politics with political subject, scientific-technological subject and common citizen in the activities of policy and management of science-technology. Its policy ideals include the constructive scientific realism and the democratic values on science-technology. The fundamentals in its methodologies are that standardize the wide-ranging pluralist participation in the governance of science, that enlarge the research capability and scientific knowledge of the public widely, and that get the good common ground step by step. Its typical patterns are those of "evolution of issues", "boundary organizations" and "consultation between subjects".
